



Official communication regarding Colombia's situation

June the 9th, 2021

Update No.4:

To all our clients and foreigners living in Colombia or those coming to Colombia:

As a company working with multinational enterprises and foreigner executives, we bear the responsibility of sharing up to date information regarding the situation in our country. It is no secret Colombia keeps going through a sensitive political situation which has led to protests and blockings in some areas.

There are new restrictions in some of the main cities that we all must be aware of:

Social and security information:

- The Governorate of Valle extended the closure of borders in the department until June 15. The extension of the measure, which was implemented since May, was set out in Decree 1-17-592 of June 4, with the aim of guaranteeing the welfare of Vallecaucanos in the face of the public order situation in the region and the increase in cases of covid-19.
- Although the National Strike Committee has unblocked some avenues as a sign of openness to dialogue and negotiations, there are still some demonstrations in cities such as Bogotá and Medellín. The National Government is expected to meet again with the Committee in a new round of negotiations in the coming days.

Covid-19 restrictions:

- **Bogotá:**
 - Bogota begins on Tuesday its economic reactivation and a new stage of care. However, the Mayor's Office of Bogota has reported that, all biosecurity actions against covid-19 must continue to take care of life while the economic sector is reactivated.
 - Most sectors will be able to start operating without a time limit.
 - On the other hand, the bars and gastrobars, which were closed, will be able to open until 1:00 in the morning. This is due to the lifting of the curfew and also the prohibition.
 - Bogota continues with the modality of cars plate number restriction.
- **Medellín:**
 - Antioquia has been one of the most affected departments during the covid-19 pandemic. Under this premise, it must be said that since the beginning of the health emergency, 561,985 cases have been reported throughout the country.
 - In Antioquia the measure of curfew night will rule from midnight to 5:00 a.m. on Wednesday 9 June.
 - At the same time, alcohol Prohibition applies, which restricts the consumption of intoxicating beverages in public establishments. This restriction works in the same way in all the municipalities of Antioquia, except Amalfi, Remedios and Segovia, territories that have curfew from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
